

La Marisol

This humble house was built by the hands of a fishing boat owner who needed to see the sea as a way of breathing in order to live. La Marisol was nothing more than the resting place for more than 25 years of a sea wolf, where he enjoyed his family and his most intimate moments when his work gave him a break.

The most important thing is not the house itself, but the disconnection it provides to anyone who stays there, accompanied by the sound of the birds that fly over the area, the breeze and the sea. You will be able to enjoy magnificent views of the entrance to the Arousa Ria, with the island of Ons in front of you and the island of Salvora to starboard as a faithful testimony of a privileged enclave.

A place to disconnect

Besides being able to go to the beaches of Area Secada or A Meixida, just a few minutes walk from La Marisol, our house is also a perfect place to disconnect. Here you can sit in the upper back garden, with a good cup of coffee or whatever, and enjoy sunsets like you have never seen before. You will be sheltered from the north, watching the boats arrive at one of the most important inshore fishing ports in Europe, or contemplating how the sailboats are carried by the wind, like a bucolic picture that life deserves to be lived to the full in this place.





La Marisol has 7 spacious, fully equipped rooms, with a maximum capacity for 14 people. Built on 3 levels, the upper floor has 5 exterior rooms equipped with all the comforts. One of them has its own bathroom and a large window with views of the Arousa estuary, and another complete service bathroom for the rest of the bedrooms on the floor.

The ground floor has a complete bathroom and the two remaining bedrooms. Here you will also find the kitchen, with all the necessary appliances and utensils, and the living room, with a large dining table, a chaise-longue sofa, and double access to a wonderful terrace overlooking the entrance to the Ria de Arousa. In the basement, you will have a well-equipped office to serve the unforgettable moments that the garden will give you sharing table and tablecloth with family or friends. In the same office, there is a complete bathroom. This floor also offers a leisure area for young and old: who doesn't fancy a game of table football, billiards or table tennis?

The house has garden areas distributed in 2 large areas: at the front and at the back. The first has 5 outdoor parking spaces with access to the public road, with remotecontrolled automatic gate. The back part has a huge garden distributed in 2 levels with views to the sea, without anything disturbing you to enjoy the panoramic view.
